Our Mission: At Christian Academy of Louisiana, we are committed to partnering with families to provide a Christ-centered education that nurtures academic excellence, strong character, a biblical worldview, patriotism, community service, and a lifelong relationship with Jesus Christ.

High School Learning Pathways: We offer three flexible learning models to meet the unique needs of our students and families. Each model maintains our commitment to academic rigor and biblical values.

1. Traditional High School (face-to-face instruction blended with campus on-line learning)

Overview: Students attend classes on campus daily and engage in structured, teacher-led instruction in a supportive Christian environment, along with some on-line instruction through Liberty University On-Line Academy (LUOA) with a supervising proctor.

Key Features:

Five-day on-campus schedule
Direct instruction from face-to-face educators
Structured routine and accountability
Opportunities for fellowship, athletics, and student life

2. Hybrid Program: (face-to-face on campus learning blended with on-line at home learning)

Overview: Students experience the best of both worlds by combining on-campus classes with structured at-home on-line learning. This affords students who also want to manage a job to facilitate this schedule (Juniors/Seniors) and/or have a flexible schedule for parents who travel and/or have a medical issue.

Key Features:

2-3 core classes on campus; remaining days at home (PLUS, Chapel and Bible/etiquette- on campus)
Teacher-guided instruction and independent assignments
Increased flexibility with continued support
Use of online learning platform through LUOA

Parent Partnership:

Parents help support learning on home days
Students are expected to manage time and complete assignments independently

3. Crusader Flex Program (private school at home on-line learning through LUOA)

Overview: Students complete coursework remotely with flexible pacing while receiving guidance from **supervising proctor**. We manage the responsibility of transcripts, curriculum, and grades. Students receive a Louisiana diploma from CAL and are not subject to home study higher ACT score requirements. Students also get to compete in sports programs, academic programs, and social events. Students are also eligible for scholarships offered by the State of Louisiana.

100% online academic instruction (Chapel and Bible/etiquette- on campus)
Flexible daily schedule
Self-paced learning with proctor support
Ideal for students needing maximum flexibility

ACEL Athletic Requirements:

- Must be enrolled full-time (typically 6 courses; seniors need 2)
- Hybrid students must take: At least 3 courses (or 2 for seniors) through the private school
- Private school at home = school-controlled (even if done at home)
- CAL must manage transcripts and curriculum for student to compete in ACEL Sports
